RANGE RULES

Standard Operating Rules & Procedures

Your safety is paramount at the Hillsdale Range. These rules must be followed to keep everyone safe and make your experience the best possible:

- 1. ALWAYS KEEP THE GUN POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION (DOWN RANGE)
- 2. ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER UNTIL READY TO SHOOT
- 3. ALWAYS KEEP THE GUN UNLOADED UNTIL READY TO USE
- 4. Decisions of the Range Safety Officer is final. The Range Safety Officer is the absolute authority on the range. The RSO (Range Safety Officer) or CRSO (Chief Range Safety Officer) have the right to revoke your membership, if safety rules are violated.
- 5. Fire only authorized firearms and ammunition.
- 6. Only load firearms on the firing line and after the RSO (if present) has given the command to load or that the firing line is HOT.
- 7. No shooting across firing lanes.
- 8. **Any shooter** should give the command "Cease Fire" if an unsafe condition occurs. When the command "Cease Fire" is heard, immediately stop shooting, apply safety, place firearm on bench (if applicable) with muzzle pointed down range, step back behind the yellow line and await further instructions.
- 9. Firearms must be benched (actions open and facing up, chambers empty, and muzzles pointing in a safe direction) when the flashing lights are on, indicating people may be downrange. If you are not changing targets when the flashing lights are on STAY BEHIND the YELLOW LINE.
- 10. Always confirm your barrel is clear after an unusual/abnormal discharge.
- 11. Shoot only from the designated firing line.
- 12. Fire at authorized paper targets held in the provided stands only. No glass, metal, box, or other targets are allowed.
- 13. Insure all projectiles impact within the established range safety limits.
- 14. Appropriate Eye and Ear Protection are Required.
- 15. Notify RSO or CRSO of any safety infraction or unsafe equipment.
- 16. Firearms that are out of the case and not being fired must be benched, holstered, or in the provided racks.
- 17. All shooters are responsible for their guns, ammunition, and other personal property while at the range.
- 18. Police all brass, paper, and other debris after shooting. Brass & Steel go in the Brass bucket everything else in the trash cans.
- 19. Shooters may not consume alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs, or any prescription or over the counter drugs that would impair shooting ability while on range property.
- 20. Wash hands with cold water before eating, drinking, or smoking to avoid lead contamination.
- 21. No pets are allowed on the range.

Trap & Skeet Range Specific Rules

1. Equipment

- a. Shotguns with barrels shorter than 24 inches may only be used at the pattern board. All other usage is at the discretion of the Range Safety Officer.
- b. No pistol grip shotguns allowed without a stock on Trap or Skeet fields regardless of barrel length.

2. Ammunition

- a. Lead shot target loads only; no steel loads due to ricochet hazards.
- b. No load containing more than 1-1/8 ounces of shot or any shot larger than #7 ½ can be used
- c. Maximum velocity 1300fps or 3 ½ Dram Equivalent
- 3. Do not load gun/close action until it is your turn to shoot.
- 4. Do not proceed to the next station until all shooters have finished the station.
- 5. Number of Shells: Never load more shells than needed for that target presentation. Trap-1 shell. Skeetnever more than 2 shells.
- 6. Duds and mis-fired shells should be removed from Hillsdale range by owner. DO NOT leave them on ground or put in trash.
- 7. You may pick up empties AFTER your squad's shooting round is complete.
- 8. An Orange Cone on top of the trap house indicates a CLOSED FIELD. Do not point guns downrange on a closed field at any time.
- 9. All trash should be placed in proper receptacles. Empty hulls go into the white buckets. Cardboard, plastic, etc. goes into the trash cans. Field strip all cigarette butts.
